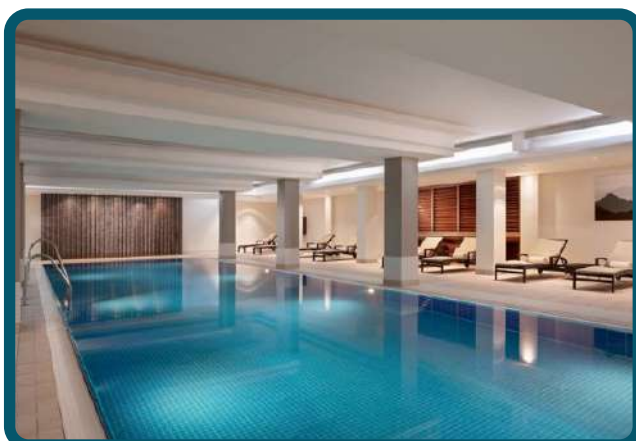
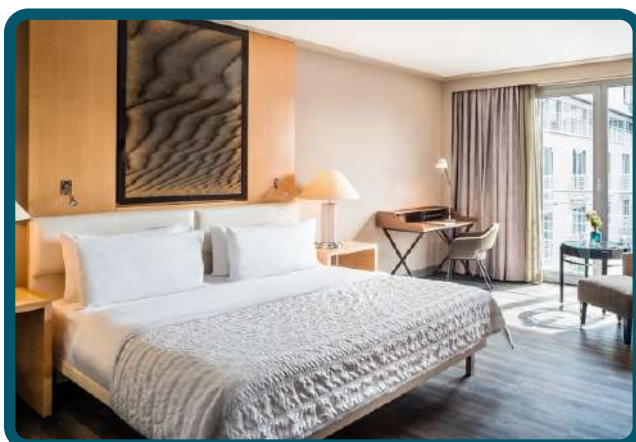
A city that seamlessly blends historic charm with a vibrant nightlife, rich beer culture, and a thriving arts scene.

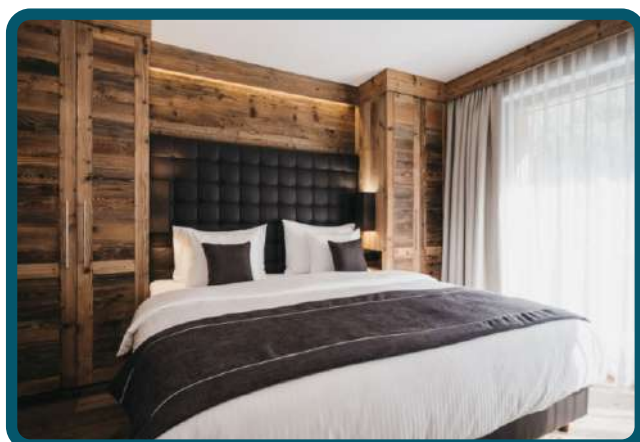
A year-round alpine paradise, known for its world-class skiing, vibrant après-ski scene, and stunning mountain views.

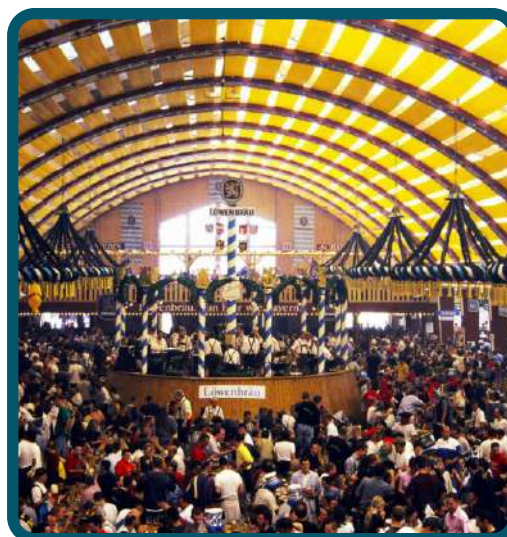
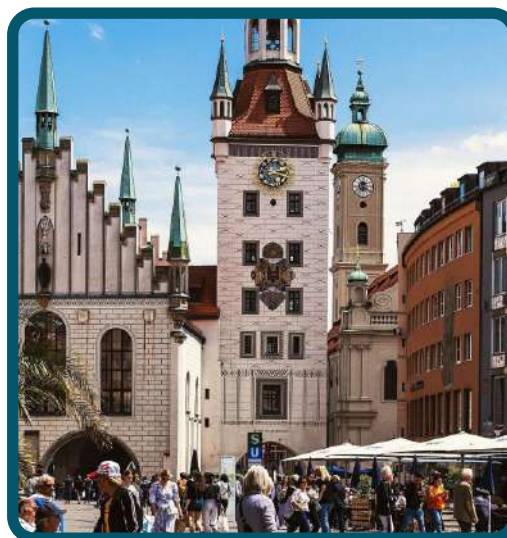
